We have two focus topics this term. In Term 3 our topic will be 'Long Ago'. In this topic we will be thinking about our own history and how we have changed since we were babies. We will be looking at our family tree and thinking about what life was like for our Grandparents and Great Grandparents. Some of the books and stories we will be reading include *The Tiger Who Came to Tea, Alfie and Annie Rose, We are Giants* and *Coming to England*.
