

What is Operation Encompass?

At Kidmore End CE Primary School, we are committed to safeguarding and supporting all our pupils. As part of this commitment, we participate in Operation Encompass, a national initiative that ensures children who have been affected by domestic abuse receive timely and appropriate support.

Operation Encompass is a partnership between local police forces and schools. When the police attend an incident of domestic abuse where children are present, they notify the school's designated safeguarding lead (DSL) before the start of the next school day. This allows the school to provide immediate support to the child, ensuring they feel safe and understood in their school environment.

We are dedicated to creating a supportive environment where every child feels safe and valued. Through Operation Encompass, we aim to ensure that no child suffers in silence and that they receive the care and attention they deserve.
