Item/project	Cost	Objectives
Specialist PE teacher to work with lower Key Stage 2	£3420	To deliver lessons throughout the year to ensure development of gymnastics.
Participation in the inter-school primary sports local network	£1500	Providing pupils across the school a wide range of opportunities for local competition and access to county level competition if successful locally.
To train pupils as sports leaders. Active leaders training in Years 5 & 6	£750	Using Sports Leaders UK materials train Year 6 children to lead sporting activities. Leaders to investigate and suggest workshops/new sports to try.
Performance Sport – working across all year groups	£3040	To deliver lessons across all classes throughout the year to ensure development of teaching ball skills and high quality experience of sport and increased teacher confidence in delivering units of work.
Lunchtime play leader	£1454.64	For member of staff to oversee games at lunchtimes, encouraging play
Sports equipment	£2000	To purchase additional equipment to expand experiences of the children.
Coach to sports competitions	£1000	To enable participation in County finals (Sportshall, Quadkids)
Employment of outdoor education specialist	£4200	To promote outdoor education (Year 5 camp, Year 6 bellboating, Woodlands)
