### Morning Drop Off

Please note that any children who arrive at school before 8.40am should be supervised by parents. There will be a member of staff on duty from 8.40. Class teachers will greet children from 8.40 - 8.45 and will then be in class with the children. A member of staff will remain outside until 8.55 when lessons begin. A leader will lock the school gates at 8.55. If you wish to speak to the class teacher but have missed them in the morning please feel free to pop into the office where a message can be sent to them. ## Attendance at Kidmore End 2022-2023

The current attendance at Kidmore End is 95.71%.

From December, the school has begun to target parents whose child's attendance is under 90%. Currently the number of children under 90% attendance is 16 (9.82%).

The attendance target for the school is 97%.
