Our children are carefully prepared for the assessments and teachers work hard to make sure they are sensitively delivered. However, we know these are just snap shots of attainment and do not tell us the whole story of our children. Teachers use these outcomes to support their final teacher assessment alongside all learning that takes place throughout the year. Whilst high attainment is great, it is progress we hold in highest regard. All progress is valuable as our children journey through school, and we also let them know that their best will always be good enough!

You may soon notice various advertisements for upcoming vacant positions, and I wanted to share them with just our school community in the first instance. Firstly, after many years at Kidmore End, as a parent and then a wonderful school secretary, Mrs Heffer will be leaving at the end of the school year. She will be greatly missed and is keen to support transition as she passes on the baton. Also, our brilliant Mr Heritage has made the decision to relocate at the end of the school year, sadly this relocation would make a commute to Kidmore End impossible!
