Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to school! We hope you and your family had a fun and relaxing summer in the glorious sunshine and are looking forward to an exciting new autumn term. Over the summer, we hope your child had lots of opportunities to read and share books with you – on the beach, in the park or curled up in bed. We look forward to hearing about some of the books your child particularly enjoyed as the class share their recommendations.

Year 4 is an important year for your child as they consolidate their prior learning and progress on from Year 3 before moving up towards the top end of the school. We will be encouraging your children to become more independent and responsible for their own learning this year. This will include bringing in all they need each day and concentrating on their key skills (spelling, reading and times tables) at home each week.

P.E will be on a **Wednesday** and on a **Thursday**. Kit needs to include outside trainers, jumper and tracksuit bottoms/leggings as PE continues outside, if possible, whatever the weather! **Please make sure your child comes to school in their PE Kit on both days.**

Our topic this term is Invasions, which provides great opportunities for cross curriculum activities, especially in Humanities. A trip is booked for Year 4 to go to Reading Museum in December. More details will follow in due course. An outline of our curriculum for this term is summarised below:

Homework

Your child has a reading record which they will be required to fill in 2-3 times a week (more is fine with us). They should read on their own daily and with an adult at least twice a week. Please feel free to record in the diary and encourage the children to start commenting on their independent reading. Reading records will be checked weekly, usually on a Monday.

Please support your child in learning their times table. They will be tested each week but will also be practising them daily in preparation for the MTC test in summer 2024 (Multiplication Times Table Checkcompulsory for Year 4).

A fortnightly cycle will be used for Maths and English. On Week 1 of this cycle, a hard copy of a maths and English activity will be sent out in their homework books to do. Week 2 will be set on Google Classroom which your child can self-mark and submit. This will be returned to the teacher on the days specified below and marked.

Maths will be issued on a Monday and will be expected in Wednesday.

English and Spelling will be issued on a Wednesday. English homework will be due in on **Friday** and a spelling test will happen the **following Wednesday**.
