We have all thoroughly enjoyed taking part in many science activities during Science Week, whether in our classes or in the hall all together. Mrs Sarpong from Maiden Erlegh Chiltern Edge came in and presented a fascinating set of Science workshops to the children in the hall.

Coding club designed and built their own cars, and then created code to race them!

Mad Science entertained us all with some fabulous experiments. Echoing Albert Einstein who once said "The important thing is not to stop questioning. Curiosity has its own reason for existing" Year 6 were particularly inspired and stayed behind afterwards to ask lots of follow up questions





Year 1 Update

In Year 1 the children have been enjoying our Science topic where they have been learning about the weather. They have made windsocks and rain gauges and looked at how to read thermometers.

In our History topic the children have been writing about the Great Fire of London. They have really enjoyed this topic and in particular loved seeing their houses burn down in the playground!

We also now have some frogspawn in a fish tank in our classroom, so we will look forward to following the lifecycle of frogs into the summer term.





Year 1 had a lovely day in Legoland. As well as spotting London landmarks in Miniland; taking part in a Workshop about Oceans, Continents & Landmarks around the world, they enjoyed a 4D show at the theatre, putting out a fire in the Fire Academy, going on Aero Nomad & a play in Duploworld. A busy day enjoyed by all!



Year 2 Update

Year 2 had magical time exploring stories & imagination at The Story Museum in Oxford. Thank you to the grownups who took them on their adventures, as they visited Narnia and the Snowman amongst many other wonderful things.





Foundation Stage Update

Foundation planted beans in different circumstances to see what they need to grow. The children are going to write a 'bean diary'. Our topic is Ready, Steady, Grow.



Year 3 Update

Year 3 has been learning about the Jewish festival of Passover, the symbolism of the Seder meal and how this connects to the Easter story. They really enjoyed dressing up for World Book Day, writing and illustrating some mini books based on the character they had come as.



The Year 3 and 4 Art club this term have been producing work based on famous artists such as Picasso and Mondrian. They also produced some Spring-themed collages made from lentils and pulses.



Year 5 Update

Year 5 have traced where their food has come from, working out how many miles it has travelled to the UK. We have also done some beautiful black and white art.





Year 4 Update

Year 4 has been investigating soil composition & identifying characteristics of fertile soil. Through a hands-on activity, they collected soil samples from various areas of the school grounds to examine soil layers & determine which parts contain the most fertile soil.

Year 6 Update

We welcomed governors in to look at Science - in Year 6 we were focusing on our investigation skills. Each group set up an experiment focusing on the variables they could control and those which would change.



Our RE topic this term is resurrection. We visited St John's and had the chance to listen to Reverend James speak about Christianity and the meaning of the resurrection of Jesus Christ. The children were given the opportunity to ask questions, showing a deep sense of curiosity and interest in the topic.

Henley Youth Festival

Every year we love participating in the Festival with other local schools, sharing some amazing experiences.

Thank you so much to the amazing Scarlet Oak Theatre who visited us on World Book Day. Our infants thoroughly enjoyed the show 'Along came a magpie'.

Year 3 & 4 enjoyed the 'CreatenMake' workshop run by Michaela Clarke where they made photo 'My Favourite Things' Photo frames.



Our choir had a successful time singing with other local school choirs as part of the Festival, and earned themselves a write up in the Henley Standard.



Congratulations to Orla in Year 5: she won joint first prize in the 9-11 year 3D art competition, for her entry Dozy Dog.



And our runners had great success in the HYF fun run, bringing home the Schools' Fun Run Trophy for 2024.



World Book Day

We thoroughly enjoyed celebrating World Book Day this year. Starting with a cosy hour of story reading in our teams wearing our onesies, we then dressed up in some amazing costumes on World Book Day: from Oompa Loompas to Mary Poppins and Cruella da Ville. Amazing!

Thanks to Mrs Hamp and Mrs Hawker the Scholastic Book Fair after school each day was a success raising £816.14, and meaning £408.07 worth of books in rewards for our school. Thank you to all who purchased books.
