Proposed spending of PPSG by item/project 2020-2021		
Item/project	Cost	Objectives
Specialist PE teacher to work with all classes through year	£2485	Work with year 1 teacher to develop STEP model of inclusive PE teaching, particularly supporting teachers in differentiation and ensuring support and challenge for all. Impact will be increased confidence, knowledge and skills of staff in teaching PE and sport
Participation in the inter-school primary sports local network	£1500	Providing pupils across the school a wide range of opportunities for local competition and access to county level competition if successful locally.
To train pupils as sports leaders. Active leaders training in Years 5 & 6	£2600	Using Sports Leaders UK materials train KS2 children to lead sporting activities. Leaders to investigate and suggest workshops/new sports to try.
Performance Sport – working across all year groups	£9120	To deliver lessons across KS2, alongside class teacher, to ensure development of teaching ball skills and high quality experience of sport and increased teacher confidence in delivering units of work.
Swimming	£185	For member of staff to attend swimming training
Sports equipment	£1000	To purchase additional gymnastics equipment to expand experiences of the children.

Impact of spending will be evaluated by the PE Subject Leader, Headteacher and Governors at the end of the school year. Governor visit days will include observation of PE activities.
